



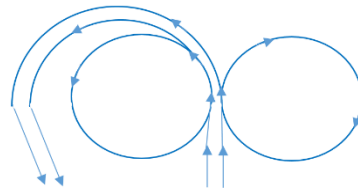
## BRC Gymkhana + Fun Day + AGM

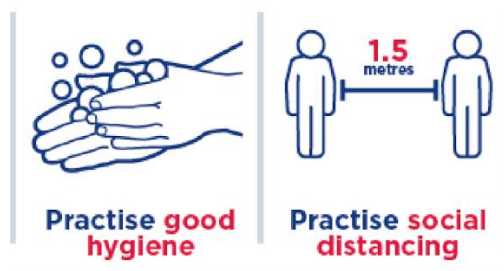
