Trail riding at Mogendoura Farm Moruya

BRC is hosting a trail riding weekend at Mogendoura Farm, Moruya on the weekend of 25-27 March 2022.

Mogendoura Farm has 3 self-contained 2 bedroom cottages with communal BBQ and plenty of accommodation options for the horses. There will be lovely trail riding on offer including a fantastic beach ride in Eurobodalla National Park along the Bingie Dreaming Track. **Numbers are strictly limited and registrations close on 13 February 2022.** Read on for more information about Mogendoura and what the weekend will involve.

Riding:

On Friday we will arrive at the Farm in time to have a short ride around the property which takes about an hour and, if warm enough, we can take the horses down to the river for a swim. On Saturday morning we will float to Bingie and ride along the Dreaming Track going from bush to one beach after another (About an hour and half return). Again, depending on the weather, we can stop for a swim along the way. On Sunday morning we will float to Bengello Beach near Moruya airport for a leisurely one and half hour ride along the beach and in the bush before heading home.



Meals arrangements will be discussed with participants closer to the weekend.

Venue:

Mogendoura Farm is located at Moruya on the south coast of NSW. This beautiful 220 acre property enjoys 2km of riverfront and nestles between the Moruya River and Mogendoura Creek. More information can be found on the farm's website: www.mogendoura.com.au

Getting there:

Take the Princes Highway through Batemans Bay and Mogo. 10 mins after Mogo and before Moruya, turn right off the highway onto Larry's Mountain Road. Continue for approximately 2km taking first left, Hawdons Road. There is a Mogendoura Farm sign on the post. After approximately 1km the road turns to unsealed, travel 1km unsealed to farm entrance on the left.

Cost:

The cost depends on the type of accommodation you would like. Private rooms (one queen bed) cost \$220 for the two nights, share rooms (bunk beds) cost \$110 per person for the two nights (twin share). The horse fee is an **additional \$25 per night**, thus \$50. There is a small communal paddock and a number of yards for your horse. You can also bring your own yard. Please indicate your preference on registering and we will do our best to accommodate it.

Registration is required by 13 February 2022.

Please ensure that your gear/equipment/horse/pony is in good safe working order. If you are riding, you will be required to wear an approved riding helmet (ASNZS 3838) or other approved by the EA (Equestrian Australia) and appropriate clothing and footwear as set out in the Club's Code of Conduct. You are asked to disclose any medical conditions or allergies in order for BRC to provide the best assistance in the event of an incident. BRC is an EA affiliated club and, as such, is covered by Public Liability Insurance. Participants who **are not** a member of BRC must be an EA MEMBER (Note: members of other EA affiliated clubs must be an EA member to participate).

Scratchings:

Scratchings will require a veterinary/doctors certificate to receive a 90% refund. Please contact the Coordinator ASAP if you need to scratch, so we have the best opportunity to fill your place.
