KOWEN FOREST TRAIL RIDE

Free for BRC Members – Limited Numbers



This trail ride will start from the **Wamboin Community Shed at 112 Bingley Way, Wamboin.**

There is plenty of room for floats to do drive in/drive out and the ground is mostly gravel so getting bogged should no longer be an issue.

Please do **NOT** park on the **oval** but **DO** try to park on the Norton Road side of the hall as it is likely to be driest there.

Please arrive early enough to be saddled up, mounted and **READY to ride out promptly at 9.30am.**

There is a short section along the verge of Bingley Way before we head up into the Forest. After a nice stroll through some lovely bush we cross the cavaletti into the Forest and then meander along the trails for an hour or so before retracing our steps across the cavaletti and returning to the floats via Bingley Way.

The tracks in the Forest are generally hard and rocky so please ensure your horse is booted or shod as required.

There is no cost to attend the trail ride, but you must register and provide your emergency contact details via the website. Your horse should be capable of riding out with a group and for a short section along a public road.

Please ensure that your gear/equipment/horse/pony is in good, safe, healthy working order. If you are riding, you will be required to wear a riding helmet approved by EA (Equestrian Australia) and appropriate clothing and footwear.

BRC is an EA affiliated club and, as such, is covered by Public Liability Insurance. EA members are also covered under insurance whilst riding and training their horses. However, being a BRC member only does not mean that you are automatically covered under insurance. You should consider if holding your own personal accident or loss of income insurance is right for you if you are not also an EA member.
