Derby Day is a hoot...certainly not the usual serious stuff. Both activities are great variations on the norm.

It's all about having some fun and only doing what makes you feel comfortable.

DRESSAGE DERBY – OBSTACLES IN A DRESSAGE ARENA.

Every style of rider at every level is invited to take on this fun challenge. Don't do dressage tests? Bet you will now! The ability to laugh out loud while riding the test is the prerequisite to entering! This test will be judged and scored similar to the usual dressage test, but please don't be insulted if the judge is laughing too.

JUMPING DERBY– TOP SCORE.

A show jumping round with a difference! Instead of following a set course starting with jump No. 1 riders plan their own 'course' to maximise points. There will be more than one way to tackle this challenge. Course walks will occur at regular intervals if needed. The jumps will have numbers on them but you can ride the course in any order you think will maximise your points. Jump as many jumps as you can within an allocated time. Each jump will count towards your final points. Jumps can be jumped in either direction. The same jump cannot be jumped more than twice (this will not result in elimination if you do, but the points won't count). A refusal doesn't matter. The rider with the highest total points WINS.

Costs are **\$15** for each activity individually or **\$20** if you enter in both.
There will be prizes for the winners of each event.
