About Kerry- Kerry is an accomplished rider and coach who is focused on correct biomechanics for horse and rider. She has a keen eye for correct movement and is also an accomplished artist. Kerry is also an Emmett 4 Horses therapist. Luckily for us she moved to our area from Queensland a few years ago. She regularly hosts clinics at her boutique agistment facility just outside Goulburn and is constantly furthering her own learning. Kerry is no stranger to the show ring, the dressage arena or the cross country course and has a wealth of information to share.

Lessons will incorporate the principles of Classical Dressage / Straightness Training and Equine Science. You may choose to focus on groundwork / in-hand (great for young horses) or have an arena lesson, either privately or in a small group (maximum of 3 people).

All in-hand participants must wear appropriate footwear and a helmet, just the same as if you were riding. You should also ideally have a cavesson – as working from the middle of the nose helps establish correct flexion and bend through the body of the horse.



Private Lessons will be \$60 for 45 min and Group Lessons will be for \$50 per person for 1 hour. Prices include the ground levy.

Places are limited – we have Kerry from 9am until ~2.30pm. (+ Pony Club is on the grounds also)

PLEASE BRING YOUR OWN LUNCH, SNACKS and DRINKS – we'll open the clubhouse and have the fridge turned on if you need it. There is also a microwave for

reheating Saturday night leftovers. We can also do Zimi's run if you like on the day – we'll have the menu handy ☺

Cancellations: after the closing date for registrations cancellations will require a veterinary or doctors' certificate to receive a 90% refund. Please contact us ASAP if you need to cancel, so we have the best opportunity to fill your place. **Registrations close SUNDAY 4th of April (Easter) – unless filled earlier.**

CODE OF CONDUCT, SAFETY and INSURANCE

Please ensure that your gear/equipment/horse/pony is in good safe working order. If you are riding, you will be required to wear an approved riding helmet (ASNZS 3838) or other approved by the EA (Equestrian Australia) and appropriate clothing and footwear. A separate waiver form may be required to fulfil the insurance obligations of the instructor.

BRC is an EA affiliated club and, as such, is covered by *Public Liability Insurance*. EA members are also covered under insurance whilst riding and training their horses. However, being a BRC member only does not mean that you are automatically covered under insurance. You should consider if holding your own personal accident or loss of income insurance is right for you if you are not also an EA member.
