Every style of rider at every level is invited to take on this fun challenge. Don't do dressage tests? Bet you will now! The ability to throw balls and laugh out loud while riding are a prerequisite to entering! This test will be judged and scored similar to the usual dressage test, but please don't be insulted if the judge is laughing too. **Ribbons to 5th place and a prize for 1st – ENTRY FEE \$20**



IN ADDITION:

The dressage sand arenas will be open for those who wish to bring their horses down and just ride under their own steam for the day and there will also be a numbered, self-guided Working Equitation/obstacles type of course set up in the jumping arena.

We will aim to have someone there to provide you with hints and help you, but it will be predominantly self-guided and you can either ride it or do it in hand.

Great for your young horse as an outing – **FREE FOR MEMBERS – REGISTRATION REQUIRED**

LUNCH = will be available at a cost of \$5 payable in cash on the day. (Think tortillas & chilli con carne) - For covid safety and environmental friendliness, please bring your own cups/mugs and plates. A vegetarian option will also be on offer – please indicate if you would like this option when registering. There is a fridge and microwave available if you would like to bring your own lunch. Tea, coffee and a small selection of cold drinks will be available for free.

Cancellations: after the closing date for registrations cancellations will require a veterinary or doctors' certificate to receive a 90% refund. Please contact us ASAP if you need to cancel, so we have the best opportunity to fill your place.

Registrations will OPEN Monday 29th of March and will CLOSE on Wednesday 20th of April – unless filled earlier. Competition draw times will be emailed to riders directly by Friday 22nd April.

CODE OF CONDUCT, SAFETY and INSURANCE

Please ensure that your gear/equipment/horse/pony is in good safe working order and fit enough for the task at hand. If you are riding, you will be required to wear an approved riding helmet and appropriate clothing and footwear. A separate waiver form may be required to fulfil the insurance obligations of the instructor.

BRC is an EA affiliated club and, as such, is covered by *Public Liability Insurance*.

EA members are also covered under insurance whilst riding and training their horses. However, being a BRC member only does not mean that you are automatically covered under this insurance. You should consider if holding your own personal accident or loss of income insurance is right for you if you are not also an EA member.
